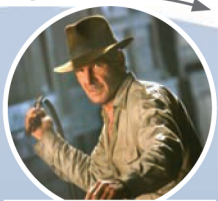

Played by real-life U of C classicist Nicholas Rudall. An actual Chicago physicist would be too smart to hire Keanu Reeves.

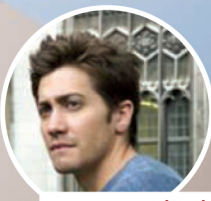
**Sidney Bloom**

New York's fiercest (and craggliest) prosecutor is a College, not Law School, graduate.



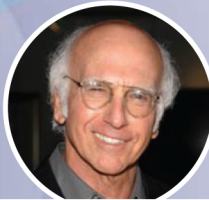
**Victoria Warshawski**

Enrolls to have a normal life, which tells you how wildly abnormal her life had been.

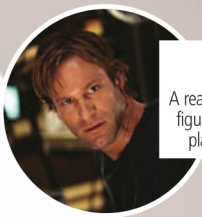


**Kate Forster**
